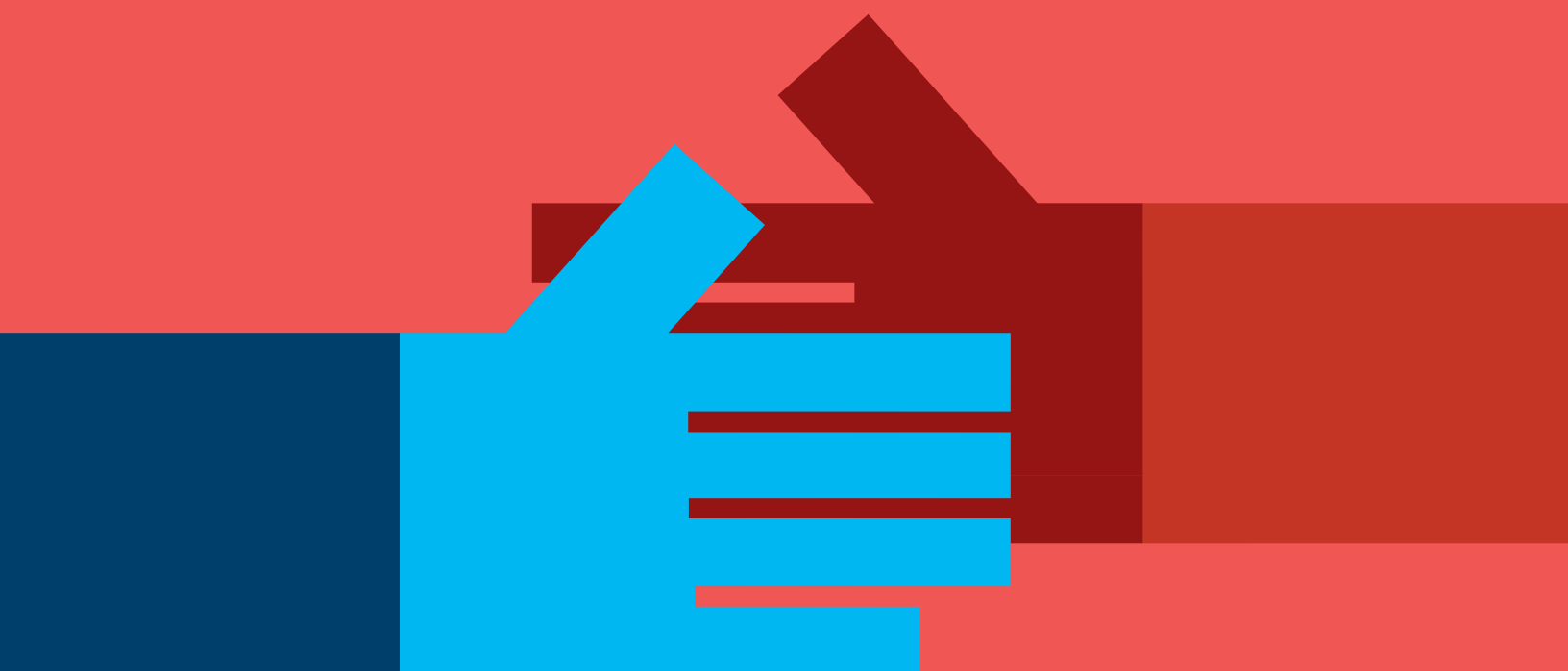

Tuition and Financial Aid ● 2020-2021

We are committed to socio-economic diversity.

Our school's commitment to diversity includes socio-economic diversity, made possible by our robust financial aid program. Our financial aid program allows every student to have full access to our program, including not only the academic experience in the classroom, but also in the experiences that make International High School unique—arts, athletics, and our renowned Global Travel Program. Every student should be able to take advantage of every opportunity that is available at our school.

Stats for 2019-20 School Year:

- \$6.2 million in financial aid awarded in the form of partial or full tuition grants at French American and International
- 32% of the student body participates in the financial aid program
- Average grant for high school families participating in the financial aid program is \$27,000
- On average, 20% of entering high school students receive grants from \$30,000-\$45,000

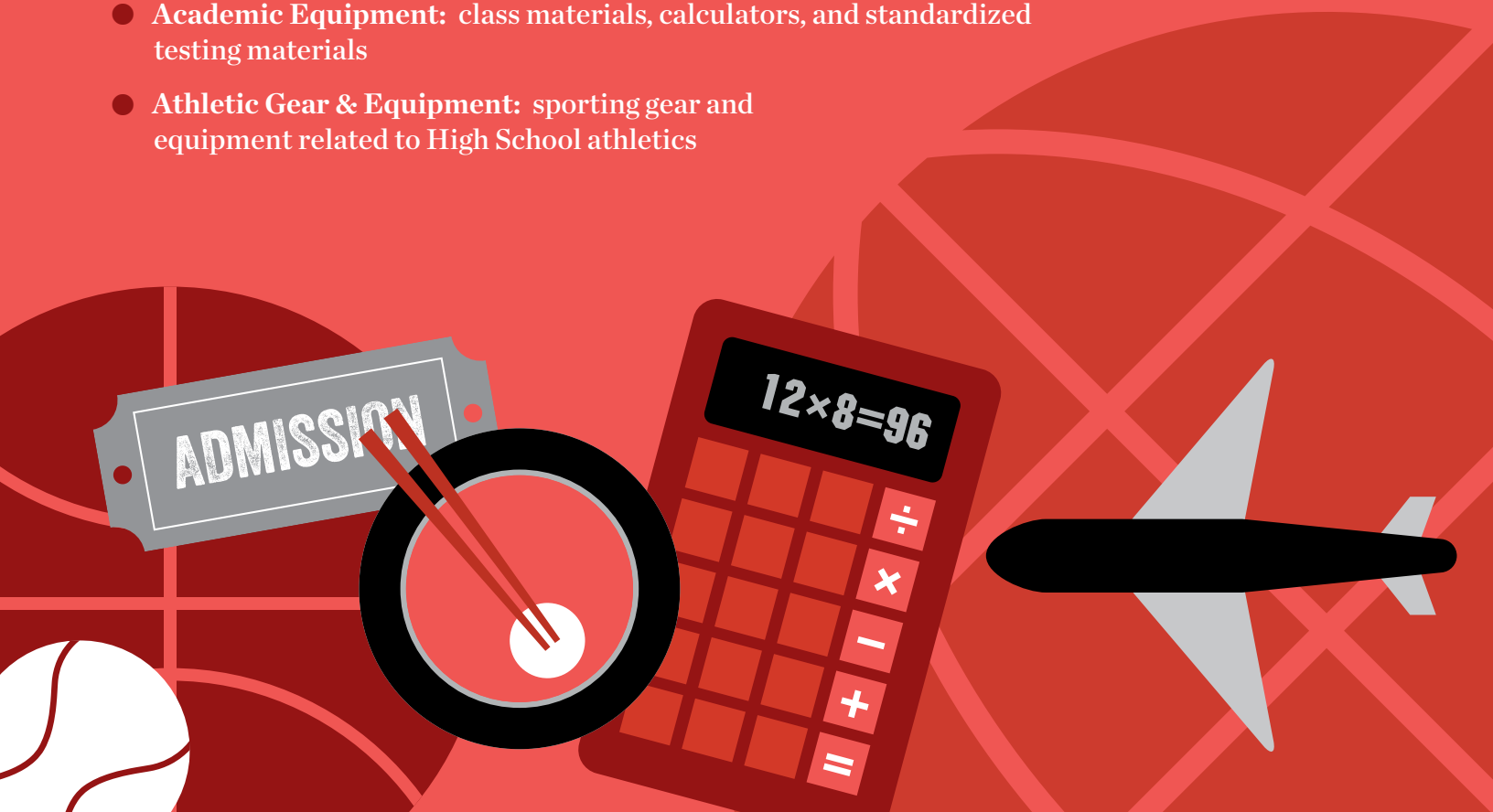
More than just tuition.

Supporting our students' needs is a top priority at French American and International. In addition to robust financial support for tuition, we understand that the full benefit of an education at our school entails more than just attending academic classes. To that end, we offer financial assistance for:

- Our amazing Global Travel Program, enabling all students to participate regardless of their means.
- A device support program which offsets the costs of acquiring a computer in high school.
- Financial support in these programs is offered at a similar percentage to what is received for tuition support.

Furthermore, we recognize that there are other areas of school life that are very important. We have a comprehensive support program which addresses other areas of school life. The SUCCEED Program provides supplemental support for families on the highest levels of financial aid so that all students have full access to our program, including:

- **School Spirit Events:** free or subsidized tickets to Prom, formals, and dances
- **Supplemental Lunch Assistance:** students have monthly access to gift vouchers for lunch at community food vendors that supplement personal lunch plans.
- **Academic Equipment:** class materials, calculators, and standardized testing materials
- **Athletic Gear & Equipment:** sporting gear and equipment related to High School athletics



FAQs

Who can apply for financial aid?

Any family may apply for financial aid. We award grants to students each year based upon their family's demonstrated financial need and the school's available funds.

What does financial aid cover?

Depending on the family's demonstrated need, financial aid awards can reduce the cost of tuition significantly. Additionally, we provide Global Travel grants and computer grants to cover the costs of a laptop as part of our Bring Your Own Device program in the High School. For our families on the highest level of financial aid, other costs are supported through our SUCCEED Program.

The Financial Aid Committee considers these fees and costs, which comprise part of the total cost of an International education, when determining a family's financial aid eligibility. The financial aid award amounts and agreements will be released with admissions decisions on Friday, March 19, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. (PST).

Are financial aid awards renewable each year?

Families who participate in our financial aid program must reapply each year by filing out the required forms. Families who submit their forms in a timely fashion and whose financial situation has not changed substantially can expect to receive a renewal of aid at about the same level, taking annual tuition increases in consideration.

Is there a payment plan?

All families participating in the financial aid program can enroll in the ten-month FACTS payment plan. Tuition is paid in installments monthly from July through April. See page 5 for more information. Families in exceptional circumstances should contact the Financial Aid Office to discuss payment plans.





Financial Aid Checklist for School Year 2021-2022

Each of the following items must be submitted electronically through the SSS website (solutionsbysss.com/parents). International High School does not collect any hard copies directly; the financial aid application is entirely electronic. We strongly encourage families to begin preparing your tax returns as soon as possible. 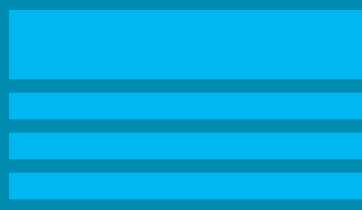
Due January 7, 2021

- Parents' financial statement (PFS), including business form statement, if applicable (form is available early October 2020; submit online at solutionsbysss.com/parents)
- A letter of family circumstance (optional – please provide if you feel it will help the Financial Aid Committee better understand your financial situation)

Due February 15, 2021

- 2020 federal tax return (1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ). An informed estimate is sufficient for the 2020 tax return as we realize all documents required for filing may not be available in February. However, a 2020 1040 must be completed and submitted in order to be considered for financial aid. The application is considered incomplete without all pertinent schedules, documents.

French National Scholarships

Tuition Payment Plans

International High School offers two payment plans designed to meet the budgetary needs of our families. The FACTS Plan utilizes the services of FACTS Tuition Management Company to offer monthly payment options. The Advance Plan offers a discount for cash payment. Families must select a plan at the time of enrollment.

2020–2021 Advance Plan

\$46,580

One annual payment to International High School due by June 1, 2020

2020–2021 FACTS Plan

\$48,180

Tuition divided into 10 monthly payments (July 2020 through April 2021) through FACTS Tuition Management Company

There are two non-refundable fees due with the enrollment agreement in order to reserve a student's space in our school: a \$1,000 Tuition Deposit, which is credited towards tuition, and a one-time \$2,000 New Student Enrollment Fee. For families receiving large financial aid grants, these fees will be significantly reduced.

The Business Office staff is available to answer questions and offer assistance with payment options and funding alternatives, as well as resolve billing matters related to student accounts. Please note that the only installment method of payment accepted by the Business Office for tuition is FACTS. This service provides automatic deduction from a checking or savings account for annual tuition. Visit the FACTS website at www.factsmgt.com for general program information.

Tuition is prorated on a monthly basis if a student joins International after the beginning of the academic year. Payments normally due by this date must accompany the enrollment agreement.
